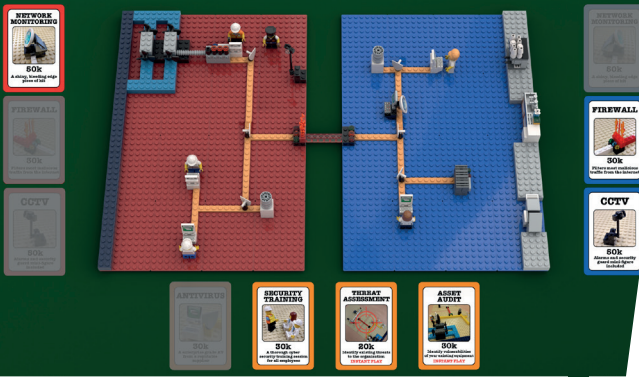

Training Course



During this exercise delegates will be split into groups of 4-6 people to form a new board of directors who have taken over the running of an existing hydroelectric company. As with any new acquisition, there are a number of assets, vulnerabilities and threats to the business which the new board need to quickly assess and manage to ensure the future success of the company. The exercise is designed to represent the same threats and risks that any company might face.

Delegates will be given a yearly budget to spend on different areas of security. With different scenarios and outcomes based upon their decisions during each financial year, delegates will have to react and plan accordingly to keep their company safe and afloat. At the conclusion of the game, participants are debriefed and taken through 'the perfect game'.

Although the exercise is targeted at senior leaders and decision makers, it can also be beneficial to other staff with varying levels of technical knowledge. It creates an immersive experience in which participants have to use their problem solving, collaboration, leadership and communication skills in order to be successful.
